	<u>Criteria:</u> Dancers interested in participating in PSPA companies must take the classes listed below in addition to attending the rehearsals.
	How will I be charged?
	It is \$25 to audition.
	Company Fees are \$130 per month from the start of rehearsals until May. Company fees for June will be charged at the first month. The Company fee has remained unchanged for the
	past 7 years, and we will be keeping it the same as always!
WHAT	What are rehearsals like?
	Dancers are expected to arrive early in appropriate clothing for the dance style and warm themselves up. Rehearsals are structured with a warm up at the teacher's discretion and are then followed with choreography. This is a time to stay focused and learn something CHALLENGING!!! It won't be like a regular technique class.
	Rehearsals for HIP HOP CREWS
	Dancers in the HIP HOP CREWS must take hip hop classes at PSPA on Mondays, as rehearsals will follow class. As competitions draw closer, we may schedule additional rehearsals and notify participants.
	Rehearsals for COMPANIES
	- All Petite and Protégé company members must take a total of 4 classes: 2 ballet classes as
	well as Jazz and Contemporary on Tuesday and Thursday Junior and Senior company members must take a total of 6 classes: 2 ballet classes
	(Tuesday and Thursday, Jazz, Contemporary, and 2 pointe/pre-pointe classes.
	COMPETITONS
	Additional Rehearsals: When competition time rolls around, we may need to schedule
	additional rehearsals. In order to pay our teachers and our studio staff, there will be a charge for each of these.
	Costumes: Costumes will range from \$25-\$75 and are up to the discretion of the Artistic
	Director and the choreographer.
